



Fa La La Linens



Everyone can use a festive new hand towel to brighten their kitchen or a set of napkins to pair with a baked gift. Personalized table linens are the perfect all-around holiday gift for friends, family members, teachers and neighbors. Adding machine embroidery design to toweling or pre-made linens couldn't be easier!

Supplies:

- Baby Lock Embroidery Machine & Sewing Machine
- Baby Lock Cover Stitch Machine or Serger
- 30" length of toweling (16.5" wide with pre-finished edges)
- Disappearing ink fabric marker
- Baby Lock Embroidery Stabilizer

- Madeira Rayon 18 Spool Christmas Collection (Item # 8040CC)
- Embroidery design from your stash or [Amazing Designs Design](#)
- Matching thread

Instructions:

1. Mark placement of embroidery design on one end of the toweling, centered. Position the embroidery design to allow for at least 3" of empty space below the bottom of the design for hemming.
2. Fuse stabilizer to the wrong side of the toweling to cover the space that will be embroidered plus at least 2" on all sides. Stabilizer may be needed beyond the edge of the toweling in order to place the project properly inside the hoop.
3. Load your sewing machine with the embroidery design file you wish to use. Place your project in the embroidery hoop and embroider the design, changing embroidery thread colors as prompted or desired.
4. Remove the project from the hoop and trim excess stabilizer from around the back of the embroidered design.
5. Press well.
6. Turn each raw end of the toweling under by 3/8", press and use a cover stitch to hem. Alternately, serge or overstitch the raw edge of the toweling, turn it under 3/8", and top-stitch to finish it neatly.
7. Use the same techniques on a longer length of toweling to make an embroidered table runner or embroider a monogram or picture in the corner of pre-made napkins.

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
