



Kraft-Tex™ Velcro® Pouch with Exposed Serging



Make this fun Velcro pouch for anyone on your list! It's also a great way to “wrap” a gift in a reusable pouch! The front pocket made of printed Kraft-tex makes it easy to personalize!

Materials:

- Baby Lock Serger
- *Kraft-tex™ (20289)*
- *Velcro®*
- 1/3 yard cotton fabric
- Ribbon

Instructions:

1. Collect materials and cut out pieces



2. To print design on Kraft-tex™, trim Kraft-tex™ to 8.5" x 11" and print out design on sheets using the design at the end of this file. Press Kraft-tex™ with warm iron before feeding through your printer.



3. Serge top edge of pocket piece.



4. Place two main pieces together with wrong sides together and serge together along the top. Repeat with other main pieces.



5. This is how your pieces will look.



6. Sew Velcro[®] pieces to top of main pieces. 1/4" from the top.(As shown below)



7. Place main pieces together, matching Velcro[®] and corners. Place pocket piece on top of that with ribbons clipped to the edges, centered along pocket.



8. Serge around side and bottom edges and you're done.
