



“PLACEMAT & NAPKIN”



This great fall placemat features exclusive appliqué designs from the Ellagéo 3.

Skill Level: Beginner

Supplies:

Ellagéo 3 Embroidery Machine

5 x 7 hoop

Rotary Cutter

Mat

Iron

Wing Needle

Spray adhesive

Spray stabilizer

Thread - 4 colors of embroidery thread to coordinate with appliqué fabrics

2 Bobbins- brown and bobbin thread

Fabrics:

Top 15” x 20”

Backing 15” x 20”

Batting 12” x 16”

7” x 9” stabilizer

Linen napkin 15” x 15”

6” x 6” appliqué fabrics in the following colors: rust, gold, brown, tan

Instructions:

PLACEMAT:

Machine Set-Up:

Attach Embroidery Unit

Turn on machine

Select SETTINGS KEY (button at the top of the screen to the left that looks like a sheet of paper)

Choose 5 x 7 frame

Choose NAME OF COLOR as thread choice

Choose 800 for stitch speed

Close the settings screen

Select the oak leaf from exclusive designs.

Touch SEWING.

Hoop size is highlighted choose the 5 X 7 HOOP

Color names of the design are different, because this is an appliqué.

3 color names for the design are listed as

APPLIQUÉ MATERIAL, APPLIQUÉ POSITION, and a COLOR russet brown.

Hoop the top fabric and stabilizer in the 5 x 7 hoop centering the hoop on the fabric.

Wind a bobbin with bobbin thread and place in the machine, thread machine with embroidery thread.

Start machine. The first step will sew an outline.

Spray the backside of appliqué fabric with stabilizer. Place this on the outline.

Sew next step APPLIQUÉ POSITION.

Remove hoop from machine. **DO NOT TAKE FABRIC OUT OF HOOP.**

Trim excess fabric from design. Trim close to stitching line.

Reattach the hoop. Sew next step—APPLIQUÉ COLOR

Take fabric from hoop.

Re-hoop fabric at the top desired location for maple leaf.

Repeat Appliqué/embroidery steps.

Re-hoop fabric at the top desired location for acorn.

Repeat Appliqué/embroidery steps, this time there are two pieces of fabric to be appliquéd.

Set Aside.

NAPKIN:

Spray one corner of napkin with spray stabilizer, then press.

Fold napkin fabric diagonally, from corner to corner. Finger press at corner.

Hoop fabric square with corner. Leaving about 1" outside the frame.

Change bobbin and thread to brown thread.

Touch EMBROIDERY EDIT.

OK to Cancel.

Bring up the oak leaf design.

Touch SET, END.

Repeat

Bring up the design again.

Touch SET, ROTATE.

New menu comes up - Touch the LEFT 1 DEGREE key 2 times.

Degree should read 358 degrees.

CLOSE, END.

Repeat

Bring the design up again.

SET, ROTATE.

Touch the same 1 DEGREE again. 4 times.

It should read 356 degrees.

Close ROTATE screen.

Touch END and SEWING.

Touch 90 DEGREE, Rotate 3 times.

Place hoop with napkin fabric on machine.

Using the arrow keys, place the center of the design on the line that was finger pressed.

Touch MEMORY.

Sew first outline of APPLIQUE MATERIAL ONLY.

Change thread to a new color.

Select STITCH FORWARD BACK key (+ and – on it)

Choose the thread spool with the (+) on it and scroll down to the next APPLIQUE MATERIAL.

Change the thread again, and scroll to the next APPLIQUE MATERIAL.

REMOVE THE EMBROIDERY UNIT

Replace the sewing foot.

Place a wing needle in machine.

Choose the third tab to the right HEIRLOOM STITCHES choose stitch #3-18.

Thread machine with brown embroidery thread, brown bobbin.
Press edges to the front 1/4". Stitch using #3-18 from the front.

PLACEMAT:

Sandwich Warm and Natural between top and bottom fabric for placemat.

Use Spray adhesive on the back of fabric.

Stitch around outside edge of batting piece, using stitch #3-18.

Pull threads on edge to fray down to decorative stitching.
