



“DANGLING HEARTS”



Create dangling hearts using Designer's Gallery QuiltWorks. Make several dangling hearts to place in a vase. Add them to a floral arrangement or a small plant. They also make excellent gift toppers for that special someone on Valentines day.

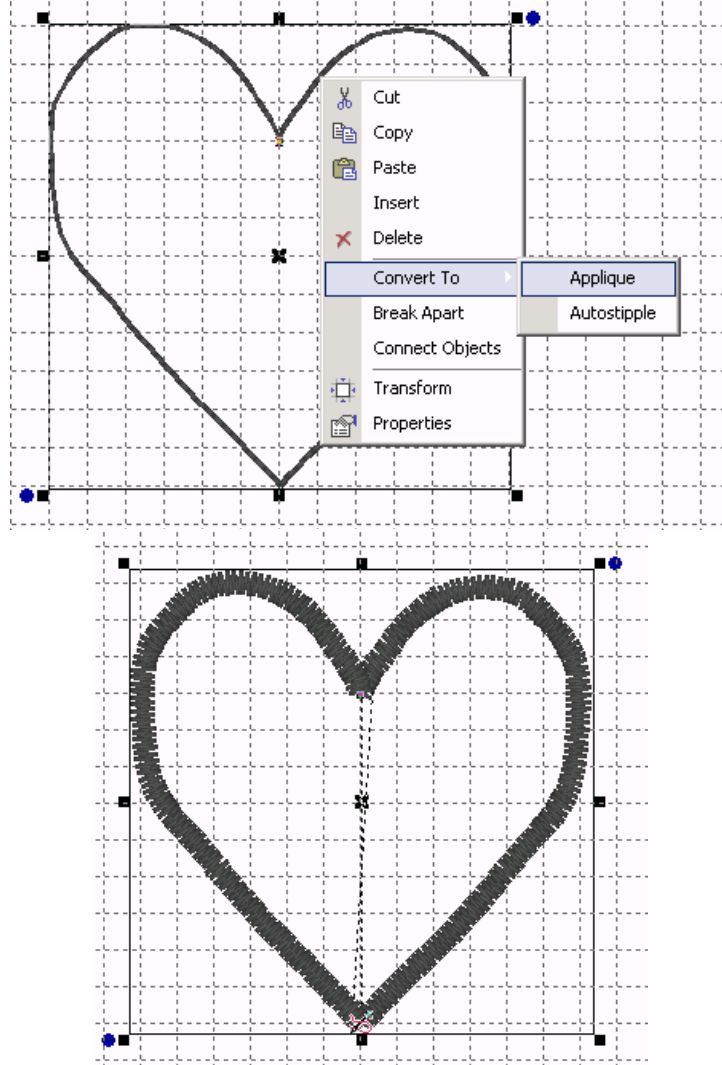

Supplies:

Baby Lock Sewing Machine & Embroidery Machine
Designer's Gallery® QuiltWorks
Fat quarters of four different Valentine prints
Heavy-weight water soluble stabilizer
Red embroidery thread
Bobbin wound with red embroidery thread
Temporary machine spray adhesive

Instructions:

1. Open Designer's Gallery QuiltWorks.
2. Select the run tool  , switch to freehand mode by holding the control key while typing the letter "F".
3. Draw a heart shape.
4. Use the shape tool  to adjust the lines if needed.
5. Right click on your heart shape and convert to an appliqué.



6. Save the design.
7. Transfer the designs to the embroidery machine.
8. Hoop one of the valentine prints.
9. Select the design and stitch the first run in the appliqué design.
10. Remove the hoop from the machine. Remove the fabric from the hoop and cut out the heart shape. Repeat steps 8-10 for a second heart shape.
11. Hoop the water-soluble stabilizer. Place the hoop on the machine and stitch the appliqué placement line.
12. Lightly spray the two fabric hearts with temporary machine spray adhesive.

13. Align the hearts according to the placement line, with one on top of the hooped stabilizer and one under the hooped stabilizer.
14. Embroider the remaining satin stitching of the appliqué design.
15. Glue fabric covered floral wire to the back of the heart.
16. Repeat the process for more hearts.
17. Remember to resize and reshape your heart in Designer's Gallery QuiltWorks to create more hearts slightly different in shape and size.
18. Arrange your hearts in a vase or add them to a floral arrangement or a small plant. They also make an excellent gift topper.
