



“WINE COZY”



These wine cozies are fast and easy and feature designs built in the Baby Lock Ellageo. They are great to make for a bride and groom or as an anniversary gift. Use metallic threads for special occasions.

Supplies:

Ellageo
1/8 yard of fabric
Embroidery threads in rayon or metallic
Finishing Touch® bobbin thread
1/8 yard thin batting
Metallic or embroidery needles
Fray Check

Instructions:

Setup - Creating the pattern using the Ellageo:

1. Select Embroidery Edit.
2. Select the frames. Select the shield on the second row.
3. Select the first pattern rope stitching on the last row 3rd pattern, and set.
4. Select size and enlarge using this symbol  to 8.8" x 8.9".
5. Move down on the screen to -2.45. Press end.
6. Select frames again. Select the shield and roping again and make it the same size as the first one.
7. Rotate it 180 degrees and move it up on the screen to +3.5. End.
OPTION: If you would like to add initials add them at this time. Old English looks nice, select the desired letters and center them on the shield where desired. Remember to turn the top one 180 degrees so it is facing the correct direction.
8. Select the oval shape and roping stitching again, set.
9. Rotate 90 degrees and close.
10. Enlarge to 16.1" x 11.5".
11. Center on the double shield image, first row fourth shape by moving it up to +. 40cm. End.

Sewing instructions:

1. Sew the center two frames first.
2. Remove hoop from the Ellageo but do not remove the fabric from the hoop.
3. Fray check the inside oval area to be cut away. This is where the base of a stemmed wine glass fits.
4. Pin or baste 2 pieces of fabric, wrong sides together.
5. Use temporary spray adhesive or pin baste to the bottom of the hoop.
6. Put the hoop back on the Ellageo and stitch the oval.
7. Remove from hoop and fray check the outside oval and trim.

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
