



“RED SANTA STOCKING”



Add a touch of old-world charm with a Christmas stocking featuring a Baby Lock old-world Santa embroidery design.

Skill Level: Intermediate

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Supplies:

Baby Lock Ellegante or Ellageo
Baby Lock Old World Santas disk pack (BLDP-P07)
Palette Software
Large hoop
Pattern template
1 yard White fabric

½ yard Gold fabric
13" x 20" Batting
2 yards gold trim
Matching all-purpose thread
Various colors of embroidery thread
Cut-away stabilizer
Bobbin thread
Marking pen or chalk
Hand sewing needle
Scissors
Pins
Gold thread
Ruler
Iron & ironing board

Instructions:

1. Hoop the white cotton fabric and stabilizer in the large hoop.
2. Set up the Ellegante or Ellageo for embroidery with the preferred Santa design selected. Transfer the design to a floppy disc or blank embroidery card.
3. Embroider the Santa using various colors of embroidery thread.
4. When the embroidery design is complete, remove from the hoop.
5. Print the stocking pattern and add ¼ seam allowances. Stocking should be approximately 8 ½" across the top and 17" long.
6. Place the stocking pattern over the embroidery, check the placement and cut out the front of the stocking.
7. Cut out two backs of the stocking. Set one back aside.
8. Layer one back-face down, the batting and then the embroidered front of the stocking-face up. Baste together.
9. Mark the embroidered front of the stocking with a marking pencil at a 60-degree angle. This is your quilting line, repeat every inch.
10. Stitch with gold thread on the 60-degree angle across the stocking. Repeat every inch across the stocking. Trim batting to match the stocking shape. Set aside.
11. Cut two strips of gold fabric 2" x 45" wide.
12. Sew the two strips together at one end. Then fold in half with right side out and place the cording inside the layers next to the fold. Stitch next to the cording to encase it.
13. Stitch the cording to the front edge of the stocking along the seam line with the cording toward the inside, so the seam of the cording is along the seam of the stocking. **DO NOT PUT ALONG THE TOP.**
14. Now pin the back stocking to the front, right sides facing each other
15. Stitch the stockings together, leaving the top open. Reinforce the side seams at the top with extra stitching.

16. Clip the boot of the stocking every ½" close to the seam but not into the stitching. This will make the stocking turn better.
17. Trim the side seams at the top of the stocking close the stitching for about two inches.
18. Turn your stocking right side out and hand press flat. Set aside.
19. From the gold fabric and cut a 10" x 19" piece for the cuff.
20. Fold the cuff in half right sides together and stitch the short ends together.
21. Fold the cuff in half long ways with right sides out (so it is now 5" x 19").
22. Insert it into the stocking. Now pin the edges together matching the side seam on the cuff with the side seam of the stocking.
23. Stitch all the layers together. Remove pins and pull the cuff out of the stocking and fold it down over the seam to make the cuff. Set aside.
24. Take the 7" x 1-1/2" piece of gold fabric and fold in thirds with cut edges inside and press.
25. Stitch along the edge then fold in half and stitch the ends together.
26. Insert it into the top of the stocking at the top right hand seam and hand stitch the ends to the seam.
27. Your stocking is now ready to enjoy.

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
