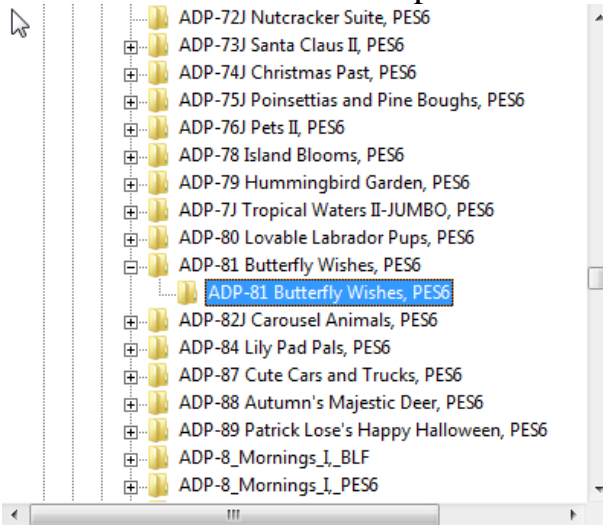

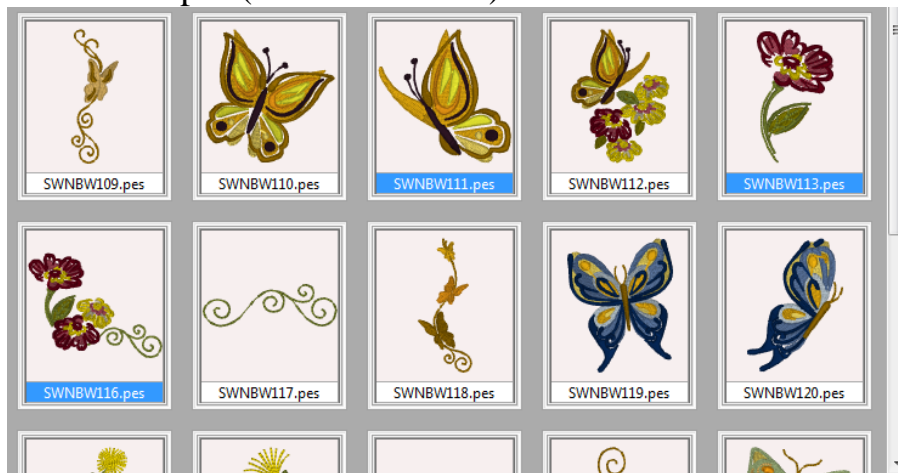
Instructions





At the Computer:

1. Open the program by clicking on the Studio III  icon on the desktop.
2. In the File Browser (*as shown below*), open the installed design collection from the saved location. The designs will be shown in the Main Window. Refer to help files for the names of the windows.



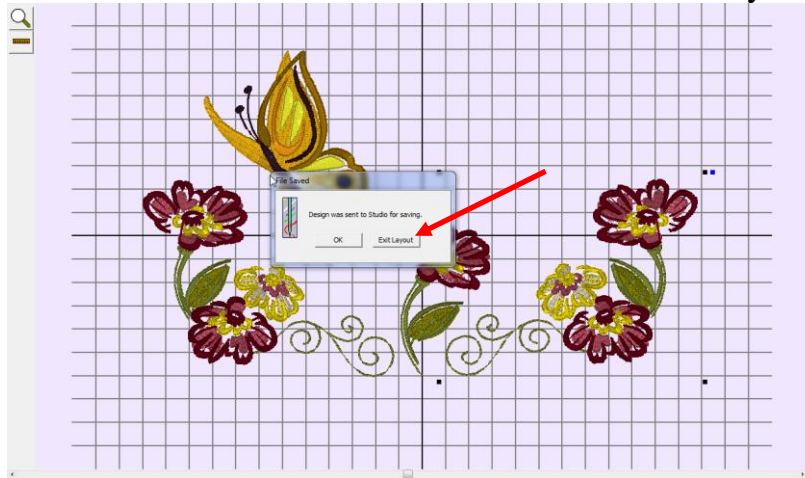
3. To select the three designs that will be used in this project, hold down the Ctrl key and select designs SWNBW111.pes, SWNB113.pes & SWNB116.pes (*as shown below*).



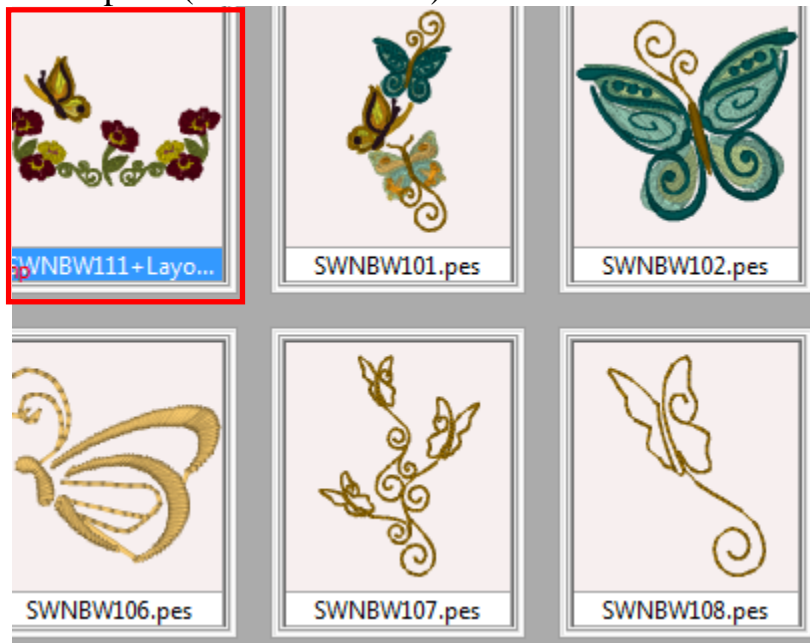
4. Click on the Send to Layout  icon on the top toolbar. The first design selected will be placed on the layout screen.
5. To place the hoop on the workspace, click on the Hoop  icon on the top toolbar. From the hoop list select the 300mm x 200mm hoop.
6. To place the next design on the workspace, click on the Next Arrow  on the top toolbar. The second design selected will be placed on the workspace. Click on the same icon (Next Arrow) again to place the third selected design.
7. Select the last design and move it to the bottom left side of the hoop (corner design). Select the butterfly design and move it slightly above and to the right of the corner design. Select the single flower design and place it to the right of the corner design.
8. To create the fourth design, click on the Last Arrow  icon to place another copy of the corner design.
9. Click on the Flip Horizontal icon to flip the design. Move this design to the right of all of the other designs. Move each of the designs so that they are evenly spaced and even on the bottom (*as shown in the following illustration*). Use the grid lines for precise positioning.



10. Click on the Save  icon and click on Exit Layout.

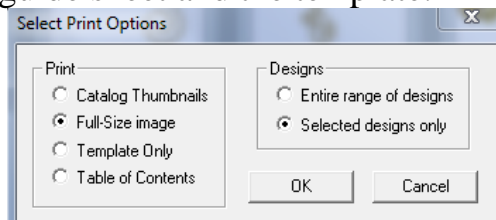


11. Click OK on the Dialog box to place the design back on the original screen. The newly created design will be in the first position on the workspace (as shown below).

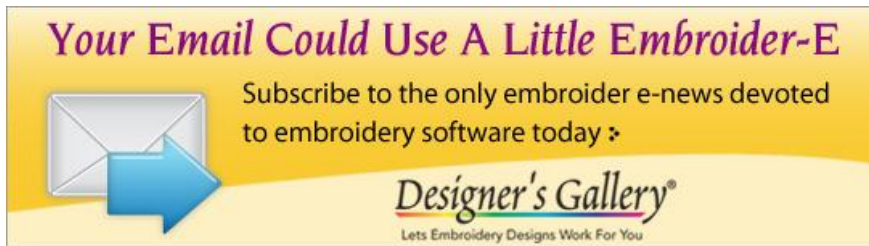


12. To save the design click and drag it to the location where you wish to save the design. In the sample, the design was saved back to the same location with the original designs.

13. To print out a template, click on Full-Size Image and Selected Designs Only under the Selected Print Options field. Click on OK to print the guide sheet and the template.



14. Hoop the stabilizer and spray with the temporary spray adhesive.
15. Pin the template to the center of the tablet flap.
16. Place the flap in the center of the hoop with the cross marks centered in the hoop and finger press smooth to hold in place.
17. With the machine set up for embroidery, retrieve the design from the saved location.
18. Center the needle over the cross marks and remove the template.
19. Embroider the design using the Madeira thread colors.
20. Tear-away the stabilizer from the back and insert your tablet.



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
