Ellegante Bobbin Case and Center Pin for Embroidery

Because you have sophisticated embroidery needs, we've developed a system for you to be able to customize your bobbin. Included with the Baby Lock Ellegante are two bobbin cases.

- A standard green marked bobbin case is in the machine for sewing and embroidery.
- Also included is an alternate bobbin case with pink marking for embroidery.

Below are recommendations for when to use each of the bobbin cases properly.

Standard Bobbin Case – Green mark on screw

For best embroidery results, we recommend to use Finishing Touch bobbin thread wound on the clear plastic bobbins included with the Baby Lock Ellegante.

Alternate Bobbin Case for Embroidery – Pink mark on screw

The alternate bobbin case with pink marking is set with tighter tension (*approximately 10 grams tighter*) to handle different weights of bobbin thread and a variety of embroidery techniques. It's a good choice when using bobbin threads other than what is recommended. This also is choice for the following techniques;

- Stitching small letters
- intricate designs
- Designs that may show some of the bobbin thread on the top fabric

Bobbin Center Pin with Pre-wound Bobbins

Either bobbin case (with green or pink markings) can be used with pre-wound bobbins.

If you prefer pre-wound bobbins we recommend the Nebs clear plastic or Coats Trusew "L" type pre-wound bobbins with the addition of the bobbin center pin included with the Baby Lock Ellegante (*see illustration*).



Bobbin center pin

The center pin will provide:

- Proper height for pre-wound or "L" type bobbins.
- Smooth and consistent thread flow through the tension.
- Proper balance of bobbins.

Tips when using pre-wound bobbins

- The bobbin sensor will not work when using any bobbin with a clouded or white bobbin core.
- Remove top cardboard off of pre-wound cardboard bobbins after bobbin is in place and use center pin.
