

Mother's Day Gift Card Fabric Envelope



Give your mom a unique present by creating a fabric envelope for a gift card using two coordinating fat quarter fabrics. This fast Mother's Day sewing project can be made in an hour or less and adapted for any gift-giving occasion, including birthdays, graduations, new home or weddings.

Supplies:

Baby Lock® sewing machine 2 coordinating fat quarters Baby Lock Cut-Away Ultra Soft Stabilizer Madeira® Cotona thread for piecing Rotary cutter and mat Basic sewing supplies

Instructions:

- 1. From each of the fat quarters:
 - Cut one 5 inch x 7.5 inch section.
 - From the stabilizer cut one section measuring 5 inches x 7.5 inches for the interfacing.
- 2. Fuse the stabilizer to the wrong side of the exterior section.
- 3. With the machine set up for sewing, sew a ¼-inch seam allowance along the long edges to piece the units together.
- 4. Open the seams and press flat.
- 5. Fuse the stabilizer to the backside of the unit.
- 6. Trim the section to 5 inches x 7.5 inches.
- 7. To create the flap on the envelope, take the inside rectangular section and the exterior sections and mark 1.5 inches from each of the corners on the short side.
- 8. Line up the ruler positioned on the two marks and cut at a diagonal to remove the corner. Repeat for the opposite corner.
- 9. With the right sides together, pin both sections together.
- 10. Stitch around the outer edge leaving a 3-inch opening on one of the sides for turning. Clip the corners and turn right side out. Press well.
- 11. Top-stitch 1/8 inch from the edge around the entire envelope section. This will close the opening.
- 12. Place the section with the pieced side face-down on a flat surface.
- 13. Fold the bottom edge of the section 2.5 inches upward over itself to form the pocket. Pin the section in place. Top stitch along both sides to form the envelope.



- 14. Fold the top flap over the envelope and press in place.
- 15. Insert the gift day card and give to mom on her special day.
