



Embroider and Serge a Snowflake Table Runner

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Baby Lock Educator

Supplies

- ½ yard outer fabric
- 1/3 yard inner fabric
- Embroidery files (snowflaketablerunner.pes--design is 8 7/8" by 13 9/16") ; (singlesnowflake1.pes design is 5 ½" BY 5 ½")
- Embroidery thread
- Tear-away stabilizer
- Ultra soft fusible
- Destiny II (or compatible machine)
- Triumph Serger (or compatible 4-thread serger)
- 4 cones serger thread
- Hand sewing needle and thread
- Optional: sewing machine

Step 1:
Prepare
fabric for
embroidery



- Note: you'll be embroidering two sets of the snowflake table runner design, one on each end of the inner fabric.
- Iron ultra soft fusible to wrong side of 1/3 yard inner fabric
- Hoop tear away stabilizer and inner fabric in 9 ½" x 14" hoop.



Step 2: Embroider Design

Three colors, one for each snowflake
design

Step 3:
Repeat step
1 on
opposite end
of fabric



- Note: you'll be embroidering the second set of the snowflake table runner design.
- Hoop tear away stabilizer and inner fabric in 9 ½" x 14" hoop.

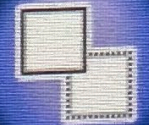
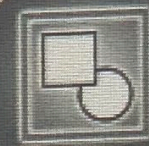
Step 4: Embroider Center Snowflake

- Load singlesnowflake1.
- Center your fabric in the 9 ½" x 9 ½" hoop
- Embroider Single Snowflake
- Optional: to personalize your embroidery, you might choose to embroider a monogram rather than the snowflake





- ¼ yard inner fabric

- Set up serger for 4-Thread Overlock

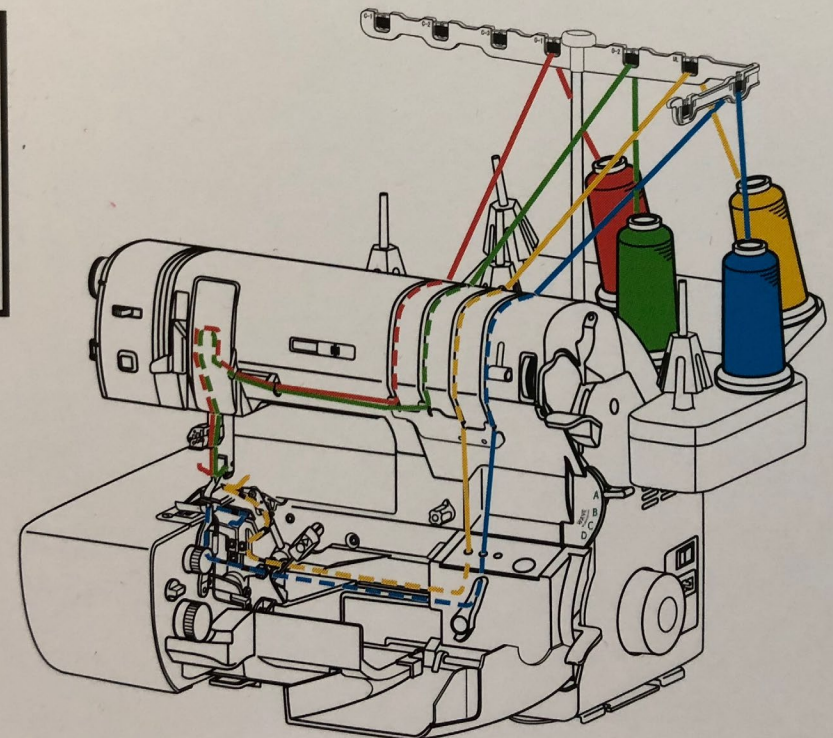
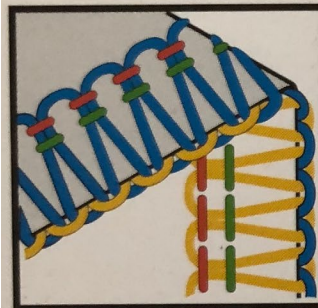

Step 1: with
long sides
right sides
together,
prepare to
serge



Serge one
long side



Step 2: With opposite long sides right sides together, prepare to serge



Press Serged
seams
towards outer
fabric



Turn fabric
right side out,
center inner
fabric, press





Serge or sew across short ends of table runner leaving a 3 " opening in one end for turning

Turn table
runner right
side out



Press
Hand sew
opening
