Personalized Headband



Create this adorable headband using MonogramWorks from Designer's Gallery. Perfect and preppy, this fun accessory is easy to make for every outfit and for everyone!

Supplies:

MonogramWorks from Designer's Gallery® Embroidery and sewing machine Aqua Set Tear-Away Stabilizer from Baby Lock Embroidery thread 1 ½" Wide Gross Grain ribbon (orange and white striped) 1" Wide elastic Steam-A-Seam Fusible Web


At the Computer:



- 1. Open the program by clicking on the MonogramWorks Monogramwicco on the desktop.
- Click on the menu View and select Hoop Size from the drop-down menu. When the dialog box opens, select the 130mm x 180mm hoop. Place a checkmark next to Rotate 90° and click on OK.
- 3. To create the name, follow the next set of steps:

ABC

- Click on Create Monogram icon on the top toolbar.
- Type the name in the Text field.
- Click on the down arrow next to the fonts. Scroll down and select the Philly font.
- With the letters selected type in the 115mm in the width field under the Size and Position Control (*as shown in the following*



- 4. Click on File Save As and send to the media source in the format that your machine will read.
- 5. Click on the Print icon on the top toolbar and print out a template of the design.

At the Machine:

- 1. Cut two pieces of ribbon 12" long from the ribbon. Set one aside for now.
- 2. Pin the printed template to the center on one of the ribbons.
- 3. Hoop the stabilizer and following the manufacturer's directions to water- activate the stabilizer.

- 4. Place the ribbon over the hoop, being careful that the template is centered in the hoop and finger press in place.
- 5. Place the hoop on the embroidery unit.
- 6. Center the needle over the cross marks on the template. Remove the template.
- 7. Embroider the monogram design. Black thread was used.
- 8. Remove the embroidered ribbon form the hoop and stabilizer.
- 9. Cut out a piece of the Steam-A-Seam the same size as the ribbon. With wrong sides facing, fuse the embroidered section to another piece of ribbon cut the same size as the embroidered section.
- 10. Fold the ends in $\frac{1}{2}$ " and press.
- 11.Measure your child's head and cut a section of elastic to fit. In the sample, an 8" piece was used.
- 12. Machine sew the elastic to each folded end.

Option: if you want to embroider hand towels or finger tip towels, resize the monogram to a smaller size.



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
